

Covid Protocol

The health, well-being and safety of all our Students, Faculty and Staff remains our top priority and we strive to provide a safe environment for colleagues and students on campus. The academic delivery has been re-engineered to meet the new requirements.

We are committed to provide hands-on, interactive and collaborative learning environments that uphold the ethos of studio based learning.

Academic Delivery

- Implementation of Hybrid Learning to ensure that students whether on campus or at home are able to complete their learning outcomes without compromise.
- Use of a world-class Learning Management System (Canvas LMS) and Video Conferencing Software (MS Teams) to ensure seamless learning with maximum interactivity and collaboration between faculty and students.
- Made available additional online learning resources and subscriptions -LinkedIn Learning, Online Learning Resource (Delnet), WGSN, MS Office 365, MIRO, etc.
- Provide individual licenses for Adobe Creative Cloud subscription to enhance learning both from home as well as on campus.

Campus will open to students depending on the guidelines received from the government. We are implementing all covid protocols in keeping with government guidelines.

On Campus Covid Safety Measures

- 100% Faculty, Admin Staff, Lab Assistants, Pantry Staff, Housekeeping Staff and Guards are vaccinated ensuring a safe environment.
- Thermal scanning at the entry gate.
- Masks to be worn, at all times while on campus.
- Non touch hand sanitizers are available at the entry gate as well as outside all studios and labs.
- Posters to remind all Staff and students to mask up, maintain a safe distance and sanitize are posted all over the campus.



- Social distancing of at least six feet to be maintained at all times.
- Everyone is urged to sanitize their hands frequently and keep their hands away from their face.
- As we have large studio spaces, seating is created to ensure social distancing is maintained.

Cleaning and sanitizing of campus

- Ensure that all studios, labs and public areas are cleaned and sanitized regularly.
- High-touch areas are treated specially on a daily basis.
- Enhanced ventilation through Treated Fresh Air (TFA) system to improve air flow and air quality.
- Washrooms are specially sanitized frequently.
