

International Transfers

The Indian Institute of Art and Design in collaboration with Kingston University, London offers Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree programmes in New Delhi, India. Kingston University is ranked as the #1 Art & Design school in LONDON by The Times Good University Guide 2023. The UK higher education programmes have a credit-based system of evaluation. On successful completion of a year (or level as it is known) students clear a certain number of credits depending on the course they have opted for. This credit based system is accepted the world over and these credits are transferable across the globe.

At IIAD students complete all 4 years of the course and receive a Kingston Degree. Only those students who wish to transfer to Universities in the UK, US, Australia or Canada to complete a specified number of years of education will be facilitated to do so. IIAD will be in a position to facilitate this process by having the credits transferred to the University concerned. Mentioned below are the options available programme wise.

Postgraduate programmes students can apply to any University across the globe for their Master's programme. The Kingston Degree will fulfil the credit pre-requisites required. IIAD Students can progress to Kingston University for their Master's programme seamlessly and can avail a bursary of 15% on the fee.

Countries where IIAD students may apply

The work permits are subject to the policies of that country at the time of transfer

IIAD has tied up with more Universities in the UK due to their comprehensive work visa plan after completion of the degree. From July 2021, students who complete their degree in the UK can work for two years after graduation. This is subject to the policies of the UK on the date you plan to transfer.



Students can transfer to Universities in the United States. However, STEM courses are given priority for the OPT which permits them to work for 3 years after completion of their graduation.



Australia permits an extension of 18 months to work after graduation.



Canada permits upto 3-year work permit after graduation.
